2. Terms and conditions

1. The Appointing Authority reserves the right to cancel the offer/advertisement

without assigning any reason thereof.

- 2. The empanelled doctor shall sign the acceptance of offer letter.
- 3. Age limit Candidate should not be more than 70 years on the date of Bidding.
- 4. Indemnity bond of minimum value of 01 Crore for all.

3. Duties & Responsibilities of empanelled doctors

- The empanelled doctor, whenever called for, will provide the professional services to the ESIC beneficiaries at ESIC Hospital as per terms and conditions based on offer of professional fees linked to CGHS package/ procedure.
- 2. The empanelled doctor will be available round the clock for professional services.
- The doctor is enquired to complete the paper work, case sheet as per standard practice and requirement of ESIC Hospitals Beltola.
- The doctor will be responsible for any deficiency/negligence in the delivery of professional services.

4. <u>Responsibilities of ESIC</u>

- L1 empanelled doctor from the list shall be called for the professional services. However, if the first (L1) doctor on empanelment isnot available then the next empanelled doctor on the panel may be called up based on the urgency of procedure.
- 2. To provide the infrastructure to the empanelled doctor to perform professional services.
- To provide required manpower to assist empanelled doctor during the delivery of professional services.
- 4. To provide drugs, dressings, consumable sets for professional procedure

5.To shift the patient to higher centre in case of emergency or exigency and when the situation arises in order to save the life of the patient

5. Agreement & Applicability of laws

- The both parties shall have the full power and authority to entering to this agreement and to perform the acts required of it.
- 2. The Parties shall comply with all applicable Laws, Statutes, Ordinances, Orders, Rules and Regulations in operation in the country/law of land.
- 3. Both the Parties must comply all the Instruction of PNDT Act and other statuary laws/regulation.

6. <u>Termination of empanelment</u>

 It is expected that the doctors will observe the highest standard of ethics during the execution of the empanelment.

2. The following instances may result in termination of empanelment:

- Any collusion with the doctors/staff.
- Malpractice
- Misrepresentation
- After joining of the regular specialist.
- Medical negligence in providing/delivering his medical services
- Any other as decided by Medical Superintendent

The appointing authority may terminate the agreement of the empanelled Specialist with or without assigning any reason what so ever after giving a notice of 30 (thirty) days to the doctor.

7. <u>Period of empanelment</u>

- 1. Such empanelment is valid for **one year** from the date of signing of contract.
- 2. It is extendable for one year with mutual consent of both the parties.

8. Document required:

- 1. Date of birth certificate / 10th-classMark sheet
- Certificates of educational qualification, professional qualification, registration of Medical Council and experience
- 3. Indemnity Bond.

Note:

1. (a). If a surgical procedure requires team work where two or more surgeons are performing and all of them are on fixed remuneration and case to case basis, the surgeon shall divine the above fees in a proportion to 60:40 or 50:50 & 50:30:20 as the case may be.

(b). If a surgical procedure requires team work where one super-specialist surgeon draw consolidated salary and the other super-specialist is on fixed remuneration and case to case basis, the surgeon on fixe remuneration and case to case basis shall draw 60% of the rates in the above table.

- 2. Rates for Anesthesia for surgical procedure will be RS. 2000/- for surgeons fee upto Rs. 5000/and for Surgeons Fee more than Rs. 5000/-, the Anesthetist charges will be 50% of the Surgeons fee.
- 3. Rates may be changed as per notification of Govt. of India.
